#### INTRODUCTION


On the morning of the 14th November 2015, we will welcome you to Johannesburg at O.R. Tambo International Airport. After a short trip with the bus to Germiston, the base of Reefsteamers Association (NPC), we will invite you to our welcome buffet and hand out the detailed train and tour information.

You will board the train and be shown to your compartments which will be your home during the entire tour.

14. November 2015 departure from Germiston in the direction of Bethlehem at 13:30

#### THE TOUR PLANING INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING TRAIN ROUTE:

Germiston - Kroonstad - Bethlehem - Ficksburg - Modderpoort - Bloemfontein - Noupoort - (Middleburg - Lootsberg Pass - Klipplaat - Port Elizabeth) Addo - Port Elizabeth - Klipplaat - Oudtshoorn - George - Mosselbaai - Robertson - Worcester - Cape Town -(Simons Town) - Stellebosch - Cape Town - Baufort West - De Aar - Kimberly - Magogong - Mafikeng - Magaliesburg - Krugersdorp - Johannesburg Park Station - Germiston (total length: about 6400Km)

#### PROVISIONAL TOUR PROGRAM

- **1. DAY:** Bus transfer from O.R.Tambo International Airport to the steam depot in Germiston, welcome buffet and boarding. Departure at 13:00. The journey will lead us, with electric units to Bethlehem. Stay over at Bethlehem.
- **2. DAY:** Steaming Day! We operate 2 different steam trains: Freight & Passenger. Our route today will take us from Bethlehem to Ficksburg and finally to Modderpoort.
- **3. DAY:** For all who like to take early morning photos: the train will leave Modderpoort before sunrise to be in place for the sunrise in Marseilles. Parallel departure of the passenger and freight train. For your perfect line-side photos, a bus will take you to the photo spots along the line. Both trains operate to Bethlehem. Overnight stay.
- **4. DAY:** Early morning departure from Bethlehem to Bloemfontein. Today we have a photo session day with different photo stops and run-pasts. Again, we have a minibus service set up.
- **5. DAY: (1)** Today we run from Bloemfontein via Noupoort to Addo, where we stay over.
- **6. DAY: (1)** Visit of the Addo Elephant National Park. In the afternoon our train heads down to Port Elizabeth.
- **7. DAY: (1)** Enjoy a free day and explore the Friendly City or come with us on a special excursion and see the beautiful landscape of the Eastern Cape from a different angle.
- **8. DAY:** A long day with breath-taking landscapes! We leave Port Elizabeth straight into the rising sun, along the sea. Our way will lead us from Port Elizabeth via Klipplaat to Oudtshoorn, in the heart of the Great Karoo.
- **9. DAY:** Today we will visit the famous Cango Caves and one of the well-known ostrich farms. Enjoy and relax!
- **10. DAY:** Today we climb the Montagu Pass and we hope the weather will be sunny. From Oudtshoorn, we travel to George where we visit the Transport Museum. After an interesting visit and lunch, we will continue to Mosselbaai.
- 11. DAY: You can let your mind wander during our way to Robertson. At Robertson we plan to tour through South Africa's well known Klipdrift Brandy distillery.
- (1) Depending on the route we will be allowed to operate: If the Lootsberg Pass is open for traffic again, we will prefer this unique route and skip the Addo visit on day 6. In this case we will organize a Addo tour from Port Elizabeth on day 7 (if a minimum participation is reached.)

#### PROVISIONAL TOUR PROGRAM

- **12. DAY:** Departure from Robertson/Worcester to Cape Town. Arrival at about 13.00. Free afternoon to explore the beautiful city.
- **13. DAY:** Bus transfer to Franschhoek. Here we will enjoy the great Wine Tram and visit two or tree wineries for wine tasting and a lunch. The sunset, we will enjoy on Table Mountain with a glass of sparkling wine.
- **14. DAY:** A day excursion to the Cape of Good Hope and the botanical garden in Kirstenbosch.
- **15. Day:** Enjoy a day out with a special steam train operated by Atlantic Rail.
- **16. DAY:** Today we leave Cape Town behind us. Our route will head us to Matjiesfontein. Here we will have the opportunity to visit the beautiful ensemble of the Hotel complex, dinner at the hotel is planned. Afterwards we will continue to Beaufort West, where we will arrive at approximately 01.00.
- **17. DAY:** From Beaufort West, we will head to De Aar. We will arrive in De Aar in the afternoon. This Karoo region is known for its fast growing solar panel farms.
- **18. DAY:** The line between Belmont and Kimberley was finished in 1885. We plan to operate, in cooperation with Transnet, some steam specials on the line between De Aar and Kimberley for the 130 year celebration of the line.
- **19. Day:** Planned steam specials on the Kimberley De Aar line.
- **20. DAY:** At sunrise we leave Kimberley and will head to Mafikeng Zeerust. Relaxing train travel. Overnight stay.
- **21. DAY:** From Zeerust, we will continue our journey to Magaliesburg. In the afternoon we will transfer by bus to the Pilanesberg National Park. In this beautiful game park you can find the Big 5. Dinner is served at the game park.
- **22. DAY:** Unfortunately already our last day. From Magaliesburg we will steam to Germiston, where we will serve you a rich brunch. Have a look around our depot and the workshops. Take a shower and pack your items with no rush. Later in the afternoon, our bus will take you to O.R. Tambo International Airport. You will have enough time to check in and organize some needed items in the Duty Free section.


